Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild essential services, the 2023-24 Budget is delivering a record \$3.5 billion for new and upgraded schools in Western Sydney. This targeted investment in growing communities will ensure working families get access to a world class public education.

Project overview

An upgrade to Glenwood High School is underway to deliver new and improved education facilities for the student community. The project is being delivered in 3 stages. Stage 1, including the new Performing Arts Centre, opened on Day 1 Term 4 2023 and students and teachers are now using these new facilities. Stages 2 and 3 will open on Day 1 Term 1 2024.

Progress summary

We're excited that all upgrade works at Glenwood High School will be finished in time for the beginning of the 2024 school year. Construction of Building N is nearly finished. The new building includes:

- 48 new flexible learning spaces.
- New specialist science labs.
- New visual arts hub.
- New staff hub.

Upgrades to buildings D, E and J are continuing, and this work will provide refurbished spaces for teaching and learning.

Next steps

- Minor works to the eastern carpark.
- Removal of demountables.
- Preparing facilities for use by the school from Day 1 Term 1 2024.
