



The Forest High School relocation

Project update | July 2023

Project overview

The Forest High School is part of the re-zoning and planning framework for Frenchs Forest to create a new town centre for the community. The Forest High School will be relocated to a portion of 187 Allambie Road, Allambie Heights. This is located within the current intake area for The Forest High School. Student learning will continue at the current school site until the new facilities are built.

The Forest High School relocation project will include modern flexible learning spaces for up to 1500 students; a new library, canteen and administration spaces; a multi-purpose sports and performance hall; new outdoor sports courts and landscaped recreation and outdoor learning spaces.

Progress summary

Demolition of McLeod House has now finished, and the early works contractor is getting the construction site ready for main works construction to start. The early works component of the project is expected to be finished in August 2023.

A main works contract has been awarded to ADCO Constructions Pty Ltd. ADCO will work on finalising the detailed design before main works construction starts.

Next steps

The Department of Planning and Environment is continuing to assess the State Significant Development application.

Main works construction is currently expected to start later in 2023, once the outcome of the State Significant Development application is known. We will update the community with more information on this in due course.
