

Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$7.9 billion over the next four years, continuing its program to deliver 215 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Project overview

The Forest High School is part of the re-zoning and planning framework for Frenchs Forest to create a new town centre for the community. The Forest High School will be relocated to a portion of 187 Allambie Road, Allambie Heights. This is located within the current intake area for The Forest High School.

Student learning will continue at the current school site until the new facilities are built.

The Forest High School relocation project will include:

- modern flexible learning spaces for up to 1500 students
- a new library, canteen and administration spaces
- a multi-purpose sports and performance hall
- new outdoor sports courts
- landscaped recreation and outdoor learning spaces.

Progress update

- We have received the Secretary's Environmental Assessment Requirements for the project, the set of terms by which the Department of Planning, Industry and Environment will assess the State Significant Development (SSD) application for the project.
- The concept design process has been completed in consultation with the Project Reference Group. This confirms the overall layout of the school and positioning of facilities to meet educational, operational and service delivery requirements. It also takes into consideration environmental, access, transport and other planning requirements.
- We are continuing detailed site investigations including traffic counts and infrastructure requirements, ecology, bushfire and further architectural analysis to prepare the technical studies required for the SSD application.
 These investigations are being done in consultation with stakeholders including Northern Beaches Council and Transport for NSW.
