### Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over the next four years to deliver 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over five years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

### Project summary

A project to upgrade Ajuga, Campbell House and Glenfield Park Schools for Specific Purposes is underway. The upgrade will deliver:

- 15 new permanent learning spaces – five for each school
- six new life skills spaces – two for each school
- practical activity spaces for each of the three schools
- a new multi-purpose hall and associated fitness centre to be shared by all three schools.

### Upcoming construction works

Over the Term 3 school holidays, construction works will include:

- completion of entrance gates
- finalising the site office area
- removal and relocation of furniture from the existing multi-purpose hall to storage containers
- commencement of light demolition works to the multipurpose hall.

When Term 4 resumes, the entrance gates will be operational and the schools will be shown how to use these. A technician will be on site to rectify any issues that emerge.

For the first few weeks of Term 4, the following works will occur:

- continued light demolition of the multi-purpose hall
- excavation and install of services at Glenfield Park and Ajuga.

During construction you may notice an increase in vehicles entering and leaving the site and increased noise due to construction activities. Mitigation measures will be in place to manage traffic, noise and dust levels, including hoarding, hosing down as required and deliveries will be scheduled outside of pick up and drop off times where possible.

All construction related vehicles will enter the site compound from Quarter Sessions Road.

We will work closely with the school community and Principals to minimise construction impacts where possible.
