Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6 billion over four years to deliver more than 170 new and upgraded schools. This includes an additional \$160 million in 2018/19 as part of the record \$747 million maintenance funding announced last year. This is the biggest investment in public school infrastructure in the history of NSW.

Alexandria Park Community School

Alexandria Park Community School is being redeveloped to cater for increasing student enrolments from Kindergarten to Year 12. The project will deliver a new school to accommodate 1,000 primary school students and up to 1,200 high school students.

The proposed redevelopment will replace existing classrooms and provide 104 new permanent learning spaces, 6 special education learning spaces, and 12 special program rooms (high school) for subjects including visual and performing arts, science and metal and woodwork. It will involve new core facilities including an administration area, hall, library, gymnasium, multiple sports courts, and play spaces.

To facilitate the construction of the new school, two pop-up schools have been developed and classes continue.

Progress summary

The State Significant Development application is currently under assessment with the Department of Planning and Environment with approval expected by early 2019. The main works construction tender closed at the end of November and it is anticipated that construction will commence by mid-2019. Pending planning approvals, phase 1 is expected to be completed in late 2020 and phase 2 in early 2022.

The permanent closure of Park Road, Alexandria was approved by the City of Sydney Council. The road has now been fenced off and used to create play space for the school during school hours and open to the public during other times. Additional parking in nearby Power Avenue has been provided.

The preschool will be relocated for operations commencing January 2019.
