### Frequently asked questions

#### Is there any ongoing construction?

Yes. Construction will continue to deliver the new Dun Goola (rain garden) and Getiela sports field in early 2022.

#### Is there a drop-off and pick-up zone?

The drop-off and pick-up zone will remain open on Park Road.

#### Are there any changes to traffic conditions?

No, there are no new changes to traffic around the school.

#### How will the operational area of the school be safely separated from the ongoing construction site?

The construction site for the sports field will continue to be separated with hoarding.

#### How will traffic be managed?

To ensure the safety of students, staff, the local community and our site workers, traffic management will be implemented as required. This includes the use of onsite traffic control personnel to manage entry and exit of construction vehicles. Site vehicles must give way to pedestrians at all times. Wherever possible, construction deliveries to site are being scheduled outside of school drop-off/pick-up times.

#### Where will the construction vehicle access point for Phase 2 works be located?

Access to the construction site for the Phase 2 works will be via Power Avenue and Park Road, Belmont Street and Buckland Street. These access points will be utilised throughout the construction to support the changing construction environment and on-site activities.

#### What are the construction working hours?

Construction hours will be as per the standard hours.

- Monday to Friday: 7 am to 6 pm
- Saturday: 8 am to 1 pm
- No work will take place on Sundays or public holidays, unless otherwise notified.
