#### Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over four years to deliver more than 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. #### Alexandria Park Community School project

We are redeveloping Alexandria Park Community School so students from Kindergarten to Year 12 can learn in innovative learning environments.

The project will deliver new learning spaces and special program rooms, a new administration area, a new hall, library, gym, sports courts and play spaces.

#### **Progress summary**

The project is on schedule and progressing well, with the internal fit out completed in some buildings, including the installation of furniture. Work on the building façade is progressing well, including the installation of decorative screens to provide shade to the rooftop area and outdoor corridors. Landscaping works have also started and the K - 6 student rooftop terrace is nearing completion.

#### School holiday works

During the upcoming school holidays work will continue on the internal fit out, the building façade and landscaping. Work will also start on the Milperra learning area (covered outdoor learning area - COLA).

In line with the NSW Environmental Planning and Assessment (COVID-19 Development – Construction Work Days) Order 2020, School Infrastructure NSW construction sites can now operate on weekends and public holidays during the COVID-19 pandemic. Construction works will take place between 7:00am and 6:00pm from Monday to Sunday.

We will ensure that work is completed safely and efficiently, and disruptions are minimised. Thank you for your patience as we deliver this important project for the community.
