Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$7.9 billion over the next four years, continuing its program to deliver 215 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Project overview

We are redeveloping Alexandria Park Community School so students from Kindergarten to Year 12 can learn in flexible learning environments. The project will deliver:

Phase 1 (completed):

- 67 permanent learning spaces
- 6 special education learning spaces
- a special program classroom
- 9 workshop spaces
- a library
- a new administration area
- outdoor play space.

Progress summary

Phase 2:17 high school permanent learning spaces

- 3 workshop spaces
- a multipurpose hall
- a gymnasium
- multiple sports courts
- outdoor play spaces.

Handover of the Denzil (multi-purpose hall and indoor sports court) and Mujmoonah building to the school is underway. Students and staff are expected to learn from the new facilities from early 2022.

Next Steps

Upcoming work during December 2021 and January 2022 will include:

- continuation of works on the Dun Goola (rain garden) and Getiela Sports field
- decanting and relocation of learning equipment into the new learning spaces.
- public domain works to the bus turnaround area on Park Road (from 20 December 2021), plus works on the nature strip on Belmont Street, and the footpath on Buckland Street.

Construction on the new sports fields will continue in early 2022.

Frequently asked questions

How will the operational area of the school be safely separated from the construction site?

The construction site for the sports field will continue to be separated with hoarding.

How will traffic be managed?

To ensure the safety of students, staff, the local community and our site workers, traffic management will be implemented as required. This includes the use of onsite traffic control personnel to manage entry and exit of construction vehicles. Site vehicles must give way to pedestrians at all times. Wherever possible, construction deliveries to site are being scheduled outside of school drop off/pick up times.

Where will the construction vehicle access point for Phase 2 works be located?

Access to the construction site for the Phase 2 works will be via Power Avenue and Park Road, Belmont Street and Buckland Street. These access points will be utilised throughout the construction to support the changing construction environment and on-site activities.

How will trees along Park Road and Buckland Street be protected during Phase 2 works?

A number of trees along Park Road will be removed and replaced. Retained trees will be protected in accordance with the Construction Management Plan.

Will construction take place over Christmas and New Year?

No work will be undertaken from Friday 24 December 2021 to Tuesday 4 January 2022 inclusive.

What are the construction working hours?

Construction hours over the summer school holidays will be as per the standard hours.

- Monday to Friday: 7 am to 6 pm
- Saturday: 8 am to 1 pm
- No work will take place on Sundays or public holidays.
