# **Alexandria Park Community School**

Project update

### Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over four years to deliver more than 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over five years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

#### Alexandria Park Community School project

The school is being redeveloped to cater for increasing student enrolments from Kindergarten to Year 12.

The masterplan for Alexandria Park Community School allows for new permanent learning spaces, special education learning spaces, and special high school program rooms for subjects such as visual and performing arts, science and metal and woodwork. It also provides new core facilities such as an administration area, hall, library, gymnasium, sports courts and outdoor play spaces.

### **Progress summary**

Stage 1 of the redevelopment is progressing well.

- In-ground drainage and services trenches are nearing completion
- Formwork is progressing and concrete slabs are being poured
- A community presentation of the design was held in December 2019.

#### **Next steps**

- Fit-out works will commence
- Façade works and balustrade installation will commence.

### Site access from Park Road

To complete the next round of concreting activities, the contractor is accessing the site from an area adjacent to the drop-off and pick-up zone on Park Road.

Access is required until to Friday 14 February (weather dependent).

The drop-off and pick-up zone are operating as usual, with an area cordoned off to allow trucks to enter and exit the site.

Traffic control personnel are on site to direct vehicles and ensure safe access for pedestrians. Please follow all directions from the traffic controllers during this period.

School Infrastructure is committed to ensuring the health and safety of Alexandria Park Community School students and staff and the neighbouring community. Noise, vibration and air quality monitoring are ongoing during the construction works.


### Site construction hours
