Alexandria Park Community School project

We are redeveloping Alexandria Park Community School so students from Kindergarten to Year 12 can learn in innovative learning environments.

Progress summary

The project is on schedule and progressing well. The buildings are nearing completion with the internal fit out and furniture now in place. The main entry structure continues to go up and transform the new school entrance.

The rooftop playground is nearing completion and ground level landscaping works are underway.

The Phase 1 buildings will be ready for all students from Kindergarten to Year 12 at the beginning of Term 4 2020.

Phase 2 site establishment

Phase 2 works are scheduled to start at the beginning of Term 4 2020. Site establishment works will start in early October 2020. This includes installing hoarding around the Phase 2 construction site (refer to site map at the end of this update). Frequently asked questions

What is being delivered as part of the Alexandria Park Community School redevelopment?

We are redeveloping Alexandria Park Community School so students from Kindergarten to Year 12 can learn in innovative learning environments.

Phase 1:

- 67 permanent learning spaces
- 6 special education learning spaces
- a special program classroom
- 9 workshop spaces
- a library
- a new administration area
- outdoor play space.

Phase 2:

- 17 high school permanent learning spaces
- 3 workshop spaces
- a multipurpose hall
- a gymnasium
- multiple sports courts
- outdoor play spaces.

When will Phase I construction be finished and classes relocated to the new buildings?

Phase I construction works will be finished and handed over to the school in September 2020. Students and staff will start attending classes in the new buildings from the start of Term 4 2020.

The relocation of the school's furniture and equipment will take place over the spring school holidays.

When will Phase 2 works commence?

Hoarding will be installed in early October 2020 and construction activities will start in Term 4 2020.

When is Phase 2 work expected to be finished? Early 2022.

Will there be any changes to the kiss and drop zone?

The Park Road kiss and drop zone will remain open and operational during Phase 2 construction.

Will there be any change to the school entrances during Phase 2 construction?

From Term 4 2020 the school entrance will be on Park Road in front of the covered main entry. Parents and carers will receive information on how the entrance will be managed to allow for social distancing from the school.

How will the operational area of the school be safely separated from the construction site?

The construction site will continue to be separated with hoarding. The barrier that is currently being used to separate the operational school and the construction site will be moved and extended across Park Road to establish the Phase 2 construction site.

Will the designated play area on Park Road be open during Phase 2 construction?

No. Phase 2 construction includes a new sports field that will be located where the Park Road play area is currently. This sports field is being built in partnership with the City of Sydney.

How will traffic be managed?

To ensure the safety of students, staff, the local community and our site workers, traffic management will be implemented as required. This includes the use of onsite traffic control personnel to manage entry and exit of construction vehicles. Site vehicles must give way to pedestrians at all times. Wherever possible, construction deliveries to site are being scheduled outside of school drop off/pick up times.

Where will the construction vehicle access point for Phase 2 works be located?


Access to the construction site for the Phase 2 works will be via Power Ave and Park Road, Belmont Street and Buckland Street. These access points will be utilised throughout the construction to support the changing construction environment and on site activities.

How will trees along Park Road and Buckland Street be protected during Phase 2 works?

A number of trees along Park Road will be removed and replaced. Retained trees will be protected in accordance with the Construction Management Plan.
