## Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$8.6 billion in school infrastructure over the next four years, continuing its program to deliver 160 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. This builds on the more than \$9.1 billion invested in projects delivered since 2017, a program of \$17.7 billion in public education infrastructure.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

#### **Project overview**

The new Armidale Secondary College has been open since January 2021. Construction of the standalone multipurpose hall is now nearing completion. The multipurpose hall will include a performance space, stage and green room, two indoor basketball courts, a fitness studio and a movement studio along with staff facilities and two general learning spaces.

# **Progress summary**

We have completed external cladding, internal tiling works and the pouring of concrete for external stairs. The timber flooring and stage have been installed and sanding and polishing is underway. Delivery of furniture and equipment has started, and landscaping works are underway.

Over the last few months, progress of works on site have been impacted by extended periods of wet weather. Construction is now progressing well, and we expect to be able to finish the multipurpose hall for use by the school in Term 4.


