The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

#### **Project overview**

The new Armidale Secondary College has been open since January 2021. Construction of the standalone multipurpose hall is underway. The multipurpose hall will include a performance space, stage and green room, two indoor basketball courts, a fitness studio and a movement studio along with staff facilities and two general learning spaces.

# **Progress summary**

- Construction started in September 2021 with the concrete slabs poured in late 2021 and early 2022.
- The steel frame is now finished and the roof material has been installed.
- Works to install the electrical and mechanical cables are underway.
- Workers are starting to put in internal door frames and wall materials, along with external glazing.

# **Next steps**

- External wall cladding, glazing and insulation works.
- Finishing the connecting walkway to the main school.
- Pouring concrete for the outside stairs.
- Internal tiling works.
