

# Armidale Secondary College Project Update

November 2018

### Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is spending \$6 billion over four years to deliver more than 170 new and upgraded schools. This includes an additional \$160 million in 2018/19 as part of the record \$747 million maintenance investment announced last year. This is the biggest investment in public school infrastructure in the history of NSW.

#### **Armidale Secondary College**

A new school is being developed on the current Armidale High School site. The new school will be a consolidation of Armidale High School and Duval High School. The future-focused school will cater for approximately 1,500 students and will include modern facilities, new school buildings, hard and soft landscaping and improved sporting courts.

#### **Project summary**

Construction is due to commence late 2018 with completion expected early 2021.

The capacity of Duval High School is being increased through the installation of demountables while the redevelopment work occurs at Armidale High. All students will relocate to Duval during the 2019 and 2020 school years.

#### **Progress summary**

- The schematic design phase of the project is now complete with valuable feedback provided by the schools and the community.
- The EIS has been submitted to the Department of Planning and Environment with the redevelopment to be on public exhibition from Thursday 15 November until Wednesday 12 December. For more information visit majorprojects.planning.nsw.gov.au\*\*
