Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over the next four years to deliver 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over five years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

Armidale Secondary College

A new school is being developed on the current Armidale High School site, consolidating Armidale High School and Duval High School. The new school will:

- cater for approximately 1,500 students
- include modern facilities in 79 new classrooms
- deliver new school buildings
- improve existing performing arts and sports facilities
- include learning neighbourhoods with flexible spaces that help students use modern technology, while working independently and in groups.

Progress summary

The redevelopment of Armidale Secondary College is progressing well with all concrete slabs having been poured and structural steel and roofing works having commenced to the main building.

The project is expected to be completed mid-2020.

Summer School holiday works

The main site will be closed from 4:00pm Friday, 20 December, with potential for minor works occurring on 21 December. Main works will continue on Thursday, 2 January.

No major or disruptive works are expected during the summer holidays. Roof sheeting, structural steel and external works are forecast to be completed during the holiday period.

Frequently asked questions

What are the construction working hours?

No work will be undertaken from Sunday, 22 December 2019 to Monday, 1 January 2020 inclusive.
