Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over four years to deliver more than 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over five years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

Armidale Secondary College

A new high school is being built on the current Armidale High School site. This new high school will combine Armidale High School and Duval High School, and accommodate approximately 1,500 students.

The new high school will deliver:

- new school buildings that will meet the learning needs of students
- a focus on the wellbeing of all students by the creation of learning neighbourhoods
- modern facilities
- hard and soft landscaping and improved sporting courts

- a new multi-purpose hall
- connections between indoor and outdoor learning.

Progress summary

Construction is well progressed and all buildings have reached internal fit-out stage.

Internal fit-out includes the installation of facilities such as kitchens and fixtures such as doors and carpets.

Installation of reclaimed timber terraced seating in each new block.

Landscaping is progressing, such as tree planting and laying paths.

Term 2 holiday works

- The internal fit-out and landscaping works will continue over the coming months.
- Work will continue on the northern oval, including laying turf.
