Armidale Secondary College

The new Armidale Secondary College is now open.

A standalone multi-purpose hall for Armidale Secondary College will be delivered as part of the redevelopment. The new facility will replace the hall and performing arts space removed through the demolition of the original school, and will also house a new movement and fitness area.

Progress summary

The modified State Significant Development (SSD) application to include a new multipurpose hall has been approved and a tender for construction is underway. The multipurpose hall will include:

- performance space, including a stage and green room
- two indoor basketball courts
- a fitness studio and a movement studio
- staff facilities
- two general learning spaces.

Next steps

- The contract for construction is expected to be awarded in mid 2021.
- Construction of the multi-purpose hall is expected to begin in Term 3.
