

Staged delivery

Arthur Phillip High School's new learning spaces and facilities are open for Years 7 to 12 on Day 1 Term 1 2020.

In early 2020, students will have access to the two new outdoor sports courts and a double size multi-sport gymnasium with associated landscaped areas. Robin Thomas Reserve will remain a part of the curriculum for outdoor activities. Additional play areas and landscaping works will be delivered throughout 2020.

The final stage, which involves the non-heritage buildings on the old Arthur Phillip High School site being removed and converted into outdoor play areas, will be completed by late 2020. The safety and well-being of students and staff is our top priority and the final stage construction area will be securely separated with construction hoarding (walls), to keep it inaccessible to students.

What to expect: Day 1 Term 1 2020

As part of the school's Term 1 Week 1 activities, guides will be at the school to help parents, carers and students with directions.

Students are asked to enter via the main entrance on Macquarie Street. They will meet staff in front of the new school gym and will be shown into the auditorium where they will be seated in their class group.

The principal's welcome will cover key information about the new school and each student will be issued with their swipe access card and timetable. Each class will then be shown to their dedicated Learning Hub and given a tour of the new spaces.

Students will be provided with an Orientation Guide and a Student Handbook which will include more information about the logistics of Arthur Phillip High School and the school policies.

School start and finish times

In 2020:

- Years 7 and 8 will start school at 8:30am and finish school at 3:00pm every day, except Wednesday when they will finish at 2:30pm
- Years 9 and 10 will start school at 8:50am and finish school at 3:20pm every day, except Wednesday when they will finish at 2:30pm
- Years 11 and 12 will start at 8:40am and finish school at 3:10pm every day, except Tuesday and Wednesday when they will finish at 1:30pm.
