Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6 billion over the next four years to deliver more than 170 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$847 million is being spent on school maintenance over four years, along with a record \$500 million for the sustainable Cooler Classrooms program to provide air conditioning to schools. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

Ashbury Public School upgrade

A project is underway to upgrade the Ashbury Public School. The project will provide four new permanent innovative learning spaces to meet the demands of forecasted population growth in the local area. The project will also involve the removal of a demountable classroom.

Progress summary

The schematic design has been completed based on the approved concept, and the development process is underway. The design and construct contract is out to tender.
