Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over the next four years to deliver 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over five years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

Ashbury Public School

A project is underway to upgrade Ashbury Public School. The project will provide four new permanent innovative learning spaces to meet the demands of forecasted population growth in the local area.

The project will also involve the removal of a demountable classroom.

Progress summary

The upgrade at Ashbury Public School was awarded a Complying Development Certificate in July 2019 and works are now well underway.

Following the appointment of a contractor the structural works on the new building are now completed. Internal works have started and will be continue into the New Year.

Summer school holiday works

During the summer breaks, internal works on the new building will continue. The site will be open on Saturday 21 December, Monday 23 December and the morning of Tuesday 24 December 2019.

During this time, internal fixtures will be fitted, plumbing and electricity installed and flooring laid. Work will continue on lifts in the new building.

The new building will also be prepared for connection to the permanent power supply.

The morning of Tuesday 24 December will be used for a site tidy up and ensuring machinery is safely stowed away and the site is secure before the holiday shutdown

Frequently asked questions

What are the construction working hours?

Construction hours over the summer break will be as per the standard hours:

Monday to Friday, 7:00am to 5:00pm

Saturday, 8:00am to 12:00pm

No work will take place on Sundays and Public Holidays.

Will construction take place over Christmas and New Year?

No work will be undertaken from 2:00pm Tuesday 24 December 2019 to Sunday 5 January 2020 inclusive.

What safety measures will be in place?

The health and safety of the community is our highest priority. Temporary fencing will be erected around the construction site to secure the area and prevent public access.

What steps will be taken to control noise and dust impacts?

Noise and dust control measures will be implemented in accordance with planning approval requirements.

Hoarding and shade cloth have been erected to reduce noise and dust impacts on the school and local residents. Dust from construction works will be hosed down as required.

How will traffic be managed?

Traffic management will be in place where required for the safety of students, staff, the local community and workers.

Traffic controllers will be used where required to manage entry and exit of vehicles to and from the construction site. Vehicles will give way to pedestrians at all times.
