Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over the next four years to deliver 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over five years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

Ashbury Public School upgrade

A project is underway to upgrade Ashbury Public School. The project will provide four new permanent innovative learning spaces to meet the demands of forecasted population growth in the local area. The project will also involve the removal of a demountable classroom.

Progress summary

The design and construction contract has been awarded.

Next steps

We expect to lodge a planning approval application with Canterbury Bankstown Council in early July 2019. This will take the form of a Complying Development Certificate.

Once the Complying Development Certificate has been granted, we will commence site establishment.

Site establishment

We expect site establishment to commence mid-July 2019. Site establishment prepares the construction area so that construction work can begin. As part of the site establishment, we will:

- erect construction fencing
- install the site office and work sheds
- deliver equipment
- commence preliminary demolition work

These works are expected to take one week and will take place between 7:00am and 5:00pm, Monday to Friday and between 8:00am and 1:00pm on Saturdays.
