Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6 billion over the next four years to deliver more than 170 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over four years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

Ashtonfield Public School upgrade

A project is underway to upgrade Ashtonfield Public School. The project will deliver new permanent innovative and flexible learning spaces for 11 classes and an upgrade to core facilities, including extensions to the library, hall and canteen.

This will allow temporary demountable buildings to be removed and increase the amount of open play space at the school.

Progress summary

The concept design has been completed. The project team will now continue to develop the design in consultation with the school community. A development application will be lodged with Maitland City Council in May, 2019.

Construction is expected to start in late 2019 and the project is forecast to be completed by early 2021.
