- upgrade to the covered outdoor learning area (COLA)
- upgraded staff and administration facilities
- additional staff car parking
- landscaping and walkways.

Progress summary

Construction of the home base building (Block G) is progressing well with the external brickwork and facade underway. The services to the building have also been installed.

Construction of the library is now finished and it is open and operational for use by students and staff.

Next steps

- Continue the internal works including installation of walls, joinery, painting and carpet in the new building (Block G).
- Remove demountable classrooms.
- Landscaping.
- Completion.
