The new classroom building at Bangalow Public School includes 8 flexible learning spaces that allow teachers to move walls and:

- bring two classes together, or teach in smaller groups
- provides opportunities for inclusive learning zones with break-out spaces that enable students to learn in new ways and with new technologies
- allows Bangalow Public School students to build skills in collaboration, communication, critical thinking, problem solving and creativity through our Contemporary Learning Modes.

The classrooms are connected by covered walkways, with bag racks located outside classrooms for students.

The ground floor also includes a new kiln for the school.

## Accessible spaces

Bangalow Public School's new classroom building includes ramps and a lift. The new amenities block includes girl's toilets, an accessible toilet, change area and laundry. The buildings are connected by a new covered walkway.

### **Frequently asked questions**

#### Which classes will be using the classrooms in Building I?

Years 1 and 2 will move into flexible classroom spaces on the ground floor. Year 3, 4, 5 and 6 will learn from spaces on the first floor.

#### What is the pale green area on the school map?

The area on the ground floor of the Station Lane side of the building will be temporarily out of bounds while a new handrail is being fitted.

#### What work is next in the upgrade?

The demountable buildings at the front of Building A will be removed from the school. This will not impact access to the school or day to day operations. We will provide more information about this before the work happens.

Now that students are moving into their new classrooms, the heritage building (Building A) will be refurbished to provide a new location for the administration spaces. Once this work is complete, administration staff will relocate into the heritage building and the existing administration demountable building will be removed.

The project also includes improvements to the school grounds, including landscaping and new seating areas.

#### When will the upgrade be completed?

We are aiming to complete the upgrade in early 2024. This is dependent on weather.

#### Will there still be construction fencing in the school grounds?

Yes. Now the new classroom building is finished, construction fencing will be moved to allow the next stages of work to be done safely. This includes fencing around the heritage building, Building A. Please see school map for more information.

Contractor access will continue to be via Station Lane.

#### Will there be any changes to the school entrances?

Students will continue to enter the school via the entrance behind the hall, and also the Market Street and Byron Street entrances.
