

Bangalow Public School

Works notification

May 2021

A project is underway to upgrade Bangalow Public School. The project includes new and refurbished teaching and learning spaces, internal refurbishment of the heritage building, conversion of existing space into a new, larger library, and landscaping.

Site investigations

From Wednesday 5 May 2021, weather permitting, our contractors will be conducting site investigations at Bangalow Public School as part of the school upgrade project.

This will involve the use of ground penetrating radar to locate services and digging of a number of geotechnical bore holes. The bore holes will be around six metres deep and each hole will take approximately an hour to dig and refill. Excavation will involve the use of a vehicle-mounted drill rig which is roughly as loud as a commercial lawnmower.

We will work closely with the school to ensure the safety of staff, students and visitors. Excavation locations will be cordoned off during drilling using bollards and flagging, and a spotter will be in place to monitor vehicle movements and work areas. A site supervisor will liaise with the school to ensure staff and students are kept well clear of work areas.



If excavations are unable to commence due to wet weather, they will be rescheduled for the following week. Over the coming months, there may be additional site visits to Bangalow Public School by the project team and contractors such as architects and engineers, who need to conduct a range of site investigations as part of their early planning and design work.
