Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$7 billion over the next four years, continuing its program to deliver more than 200 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Project overview

A project is underway to upgrade Bangalow Public School. The upgrade will include:

- Eight new permanent, innovative teaching and learning spaces.
- Refurbishment of some existing teaching and learning spaces.
- Internal refurbishment of heritage building to provide administration space.
- Conversion of existing teaching spaces to create a new, larger library.
- Upgraded landscaping.

Progress summary

Funding for planning the upgrade was approved by the NSW Government in mid-2019. That funding allowed for preliminary site investigations and development of a business case and master plan in consultation with the school.

Over recent months we have finalised the concept design for the upgrade in consultation with the Project Reference Group (PRG). The upgrade project is now fully funded and has received formal NSW Government approval to proceed.

An early contractor involvement (ECI) contract has now been awarded. This enables the building contractor to work closely with the school and project team to finalise the schematic design prior to construction commencing.

Next steps

- Finalise schematic design.
- Finalise construction staging approach.
- Prepare development application (DA) for lodgement.
- Conduct community information sessions.

Concept design

The concept design for the upgrade focuses on situating learning spaces around a protected school courtyard. There will be distinct and different outdoor spaces for active play and learning. Administration will be relocated to the heritage building which will be refurbished. Positioning administration towards the front of the school, adjacent to Byron Street, will make it clearer to the community where the public entry to the school is and make wayfinding through the school more intuitive. We look forward to sharing the concept design with the community at information sessions in Term 2 2021.

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Frequently asked questions

How has the design been developed?

Workshops were held with staff, students and other stakeholders to understand what kinds of learning and recreation spaces Bangalow Public School requires. These factors, together with current trends in education and learning, were used to guide the scope of work and design process.

Where are the designs up to?

An early contractor involvement (ECI) contract has now been awarded for the project. This enables the building contractor to work closely with the school and project team to finalise the design prior to construction commencing. We are also working through the planning approval process.

What is the statutory planning approval pathway for the project?

We are currently finalising the development application (DA) for the project. It is expected that the DA will be lodged with Byron Shire Council within the next three months. After lodgement council will place the DA on public exhibition so the community can view the documents and provide comment.

It is possible that some work at the school may be able to progress as exempt or complying development. We will keep the community informed well in advance of any work taking place at the school.

What is an ECI contract?

ECI stands for Early Contractor Involvement, which is a method of construction contracting that allows a builder to become involved before the design has been completed. This means we enter into an agreement with the contractor to provide their knowledge and skills as a builder in the early design phases of the project. When design is finalised, the contractor may be engaged to complete main construction works.

When will construction commence?

Construction is anticipated to commence in late 2021, following planning approvals.

When will I find out more?

In Term 2 we will be holding community information sessions which provide an opportunity to view the concept plans and talk to representatives of the project team.

Our website will continue to have up-to-date information about the project and we will also share information with the community via regular project updates.

We are committed to working together with our school communities and other stakeholders to deliver the best possible learning facilities for students.
