Project overview

A project is underway to upgrade Bangalow Public School. The upgrade will include eight new permanent learning spaces, refurbishment of some existing learning spaces, internal refurbishment of the heritage building to provide administration space, conversion of existing learning spaces to create a new, larger library and landscaping.

Progress summary

The Development Application (DA) for construction of the new classroom building and refurbishment of the heritage building, has been lodged with Byron Shire Council.

All submissions can be made directly to council during the public exhibition period.

Under a separate planning pathway, a Review of Environmental Factors (REF) is also being done for the refurbishment of Blocks F and H.
