Bangalow Public School Project update | December 2022

Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$8.6 billion in school infrastructure over the next four years, continuing its program to deliver 160 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. This builds on the more than \$9.1 billion invested in projects delivered since 2017, a program of \$17.7 billion in public education infrastructure.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Project overview

A project is underway to upgrade Bangalow Public School. The upgrade includes eight new permanent learning spaces, internal refurbishment of the heritage building to deliver administration space, and landscaping.

The projected completion date for this project is early 2024.

Progress summary

The contractor has finished putting in in-ground services, such as plumbing, cabling and electrical wiring. They have also poured the ground floor concrete slab and finished building the structural walls of the ground floor of Building I, which will add new homebases to the school. The next step, which they've begun, is to start work on the first floor concrete slab of the building.

As advised in our September Project Update, students were using the Bangalow Showground on a temporary basis while works on the school oval took place to help prevent future flooding. Some of the school oval has since been handed back, so the Showground is no longer being used for play space, with students using the school oval instead.

Next steps

Over the coming months, the contractor will start work on Building I's outer brick wall and build the structural walls and roof structure for the first floor. They'll also start putting services into the building, such as electricity and plumbing.

Block D, the maintenance (GA) shed, will be demolished shortly and work on Block J – a new amenities block - will also begin.

Summer works

There will be no work on site from 24 December – 8 January. Work will continue from 9 January 2023.
