Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over the next four years to deliver 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over five years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

Progress summary

An upgrade is underway at Banksia Road Public School. This project will deliver a new, two storey building with four new learning spaces, administration and staff facilities, school access improvement works, and landscaping.

Current works include installing piers, and starting the ground floor slab.

Summer school holiday works

During the summer school holidays, detailed excavation works will continue, and a concrete pour is scheduled for the ground floor slab of the new building.

In line with our Construction Management Plan, the contractor will continue to implement dust and noise control measures.

Traffic control and security measures will also be in place where required for the safety of the community.

We are here to make sure this work is carried out safely and efficiently. During this time we will be working collaboratively with the school community and neighbours to ensure that disruptions to the wider community are minimised.

Frequently asked questions

What works will be completed over the holidays?

During the summer school holidays detailed excavation works will continue, and a concrete pour is scheduled for the ground floor slab of the new building.

What are the construction working hours?

Works hours will be 7.00am to 5.00pm Monday to Friday, and 8.00am to 1.00pm on Saturdays. No work will take place on Sunday or public holidays.

Will construction take place over Christmas and New Year?

Construction works at Banksia Road Public School will stop at close of business on 20 December 2019 and resume on 6 January 2020.

What safety measures will be in place?

The health and safety of the community is our highest priority. Temporary fencing has been installed around the construction site to secure the area and prevent public access.

What steps will be taken to control noise and dust impacts?

In line with our Construction Management Plan, the contractor will continue to implement dust and noise control measures.

Dust and noise will be minimised through the use of hoarding and shade cloth. Dust is also controlled by spraying water during earth works whenever permissible under water-use restrictions.

How will traffic be managed?

Traffic management will be in place where required for the safety of students, staff, the local community and workers. Traffic controllers will be used where required to manage entry and exit of vehicles to and from the construction site. Vehicles will give way to pedestrians at all times.
