Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over four years to deliver more than 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over five years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

Banksia Road Public School upgrade

A project is underway to upgrade Banksia Road Public School. The upgrade will deliver a new, two storey building with four new learning spaces and administration and staff facilities, refurbishment of the existing administration building into two new learning spaces, school access improvement works, and landscaping.

Progress summary

The construction contract was awarded to Barbro Constructions Pty Ltd in late 2019.

We have consulted with the school to confirm the concept and schematic designs and discussions are ongoing to finalise the detailed design.

Works update

Works are progressing well on the new two storey building. The first floor slab has been poured in preparation for a concrete pour of the columns and lift shaft walls.

Works will then commence on the installation of the structural steel for the roof of the new two storey building.

Ausgrid is undertaking works to complete a power upgrade to the school. As part of these works a power outage has been planned for March 2020. The power outage will not impact on school operations, however some local residents will be impacted. Ausgrid will notify impacted residents via a letterbox drop closer to the date.

Work hours

Construction is taking place between 7:00am to 5:00pm Monday to Friday, and 8:00am and 1:00pm on Saturdays. No work will take place on Sundays or public holidays unless approved and notification is provided.
