Project update | December 2021

Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$7.9 billion over the next four years, continuing its program to deliver 215 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Project overview

A project is underway to upgrade Bexhill Public School. The project will deliver: five new permanent learning spaces, an upgraded administration building, an upgraded OSCH and staff spaces in the former principal's residence, refurbishment of the community hall for shared use by the school, and an upgraded sports court and landscaping.

Progress summary

Refurbishments to Block A are currently underway to provide improved administration spaces for the school including the principal's office, staff room, school office and sick bay. Work activities include: internal strip out, demolition and installation of new internal walls and utility services. We anticipate that Building A will be ready for use in early 2022.

Next steps

The Development Application (DA) lodged in September 2021 is currently being assessed by Lismore City Council and a decision is expected in early 2022. Main works construction will follow which will include the construction of the new single-storey teaching blocks and refurbishment of the shared community and school hall.

Block A works will continue over the summer holidays to maximise delivery while students are not on site. The worksite will be shut down between Friday 24 December, 2021 to 4 January, 2022 in line with the Christmas break.
