## Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$7.9 billion over the next four years, continuing its program to deliver 215 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

## Project overview

A project is underway to upgrade Bexhill Public School. The project will deliver: five new permanent learning spaces, an upgraded administration building, an upgraded OSCH and staff spaces in the former's principal's residence, refurbishment of the community hall for shared use by the school, and an upgraded sports court and landscaping.

## Progress summary

Lismore City Council has approved the Development Application (DA) for the remainder of the upgrade at Bexhill Public School. The DA can be found by searching Lismore City Council's website (Year: 2021, Application Number: 469): <https://tracker.lismore.nsw.gov.au>.

School Infrastructure NSW now have all the necessary planning consents for the upgrade project.

## Next steps

Works are continuing on the new administration building, which is being delivered under a Review of Environmental Factors (REF) planning pathway. These works are anticipated to be complete by April 2022. Works will start on the remainder of the upgrade in the coming weeks. This will include construction of the new permanent learning spaces, upgraded sports courts and a refurbishment of the new community hall.

Construction has been affected by COVID-19 and Public Health Orders, which continues to impact the number of workers able to work on site and the supply of materials. All works on the school upgrade are now anticipated to be complete by mid 2023.
