The NSW Government is investing \$8.6 billion in school infrastructure over the next four years, continuing its program to deliver 160 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. This builds on the more than \$9.1 billion invested in projects delivered since 2017, a program of \$17.7 billion in public education infrastructure.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Project overview

A project is underway to upgrade Birrong Boys High School and Birrong Girls High School to bring students updated educational facilities and support the local community. The project has been approved to proceed to the delivery phase and, subject to development consent, will deliver:

- additional permanent learning spaces,
- upgraded halls and student amenities,
- new specialised learning facilities.

We have completed master planning and concept designs for the upgrades and are now working with school leadership to develop the schematic design. The schematic design will further consider the educational, operational and service delivery requirements of each school using the latest design standards.

The next step is to develop the schematic design for the upgrades which includes the internal layout of spaces and how they will function. We will also be preparing documentation required for the statutory planning approval process.
