

Birrong Boys High School

Works notification

4 August 2022

A project is underway to upgrade Birrong Boys High School and Birrong Girls High School to bring students updated educational facilities and support the local community. The project will provide additional permanent learning spaces and core facilities to support the growing population in Western Sydney.

Remediation activities

During site investigations as part of planning for the Birrong Boys High School upgrade, asbestos containing material was found in grounds in multiple locations around the school site. As a precaution, the areas have been isolated to keep students, staff and school visitors separate.

We are following all the advice and protocols of asbestos removalists, assessors and other experts.

The areas will be remediated in accordance with SafeWork NSW regulations and the Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors, and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies and guidelines.

Work will take place on Thursday 4 August 2022. All asbestos containing material will be removed outside of school hours.

Testing will be completed to ensure the area has been fully remediated. The school will receive a clearance certificate before the areas are reopened to students and staff.

The health, safety, and well-being of the school and the local community is our highest priority and we will continue to keep the community updated.
