Birrong Boys High School Project update | July 2024



Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the 2024-25 Budget is delivering record education funding, including \$3.6 billion for new and upgraded schools in Western Sydney. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world class public education.

Project overview

A project is underway to upgrade Birrong Boys High School and Birrong Girls High School. The project will deliver upgraded facilities to support the learning needs of the local community.

Progress update

Construction is continuing at the site of the Birrong Boys High School upgrade. During Term 2 we started roof and façade works for building I which is the new school hall. We have also begun refurbishment of the hall's change rooms and bathrooms.

We have continued building the structure of the new teaching facilities, building N, which will host the new school administration facilities, wood and metal workshops, food technology and science units, and general classrooms.

We have progressed the design of the refurbishment works for existing buildings A, D, and G which will take place during the next stage of the project. Work on these buildings is scheduled to start in early 2025.

Next steps

In Term 3 we are expecting to complete the structure of building N and install the roof to close it off from the weather. This will enable us to begin the internal works like installing walls, doors, and fittings. We also expect to begin preparing the ground where the new sports court will be, as well as starting the landscaping of the surrounding area.

School holiday works – outside of construction hours

In the upcoming school holidays, works to install a water connection to the new hydrant line at Birrong Boys High School will take place between Sunday **7** July and Friday **19** July. The works will require a partial lane closure on Cooper Road and will occur between **5 pm and 1 am** during these dates to minimise impact to surrounding traffic. The works include:

- excavating a portion of the footpath on Cooper Road
- installing new pipework
- asphalting a portion of the footpath, once the works are complete.

Traffic management will be in place during the works which will be undertaken by an approved Sydney Water Authority contractor. See the map below for more details.
