### Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the 2024-25 Budget is delivering record education funding, including \$3.6 billion for new and upgraded schools in Western Sydney. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world class public education.

### Project overview

A project is underway to upgrade Birrong Boys High School and Birrong Girls High School. The project will deliver upgraded facilities to support the learning needs of the local community.

### Progress update

Construction has continued at the site of the Birrong Girls High School upgrade. During Term 2 we have continued to build the structure of the new hall and have begun to install the walls and roof structure.

We have progressed building the structure of the new building A which will host the new school administration facilities, general classrooms and a visual arts learning unit. We have finished the design for the refurbishment of building H which will take place in the next stage of the project. Works within this building is scheduled to start early next year.

### Next steps

In Term 3 we are expecting to complete the structure and installation of the roofs for building A and the new hall to close these off to the weather. This will enable us to begin the internal works like installing walls, doors, and fittings.

## School holiday works – electrical upgrade works

In the upcoming school holidays, works will take place to install the school's new electricity substation located on Cooper Road. Works will begin from **Monday 8 July** until **Friday 19 July 2024** between **7 am and 5 pm**. The works will require closing the footpath along both sides of Cooper Road. Traffic management and signage will be in place to guide pedestrians and traffic as required. See map below for more information.

Other works during the school holidays include:

- rearranging the existing fence in preparation for installation of a hydrant booster
- removing some trees within the school's southern car park
- preparatory works to enable linking the new building A to the existing building B.
