# Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$8.6 billion in school infrastructure over the next four years, continuing its program to deliver 160 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. This builds on the more than \$9.1 billion invested in projects delivered since 2017, a program of \$17.7 billion in public education infrastructure.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

# **Project overview**

A project is underway to upgrade Birrong Boys High School and Birrong Girls High School to bring students the latest educational facilities and support the local community. The project will provide additional permanent learning spaces and core facilities to support the growing population in Western Sydney.

#### **Progress summary**

We are currently in the planning phase for the upgrade. Consultants such as architects and project managers have been appointed to assist us with the project. We have undertaken some investigative works at the school sites to assist us in developing design options. We are establishing a project governance framework, and understanding operational, educational and service delivery factors associated with the project.

### **Next steps**

We will begin to engage technical specialists, local council and other government agencies to assist us with the project. We will undertake workshops with the schools to progress the design process. The project will then go through a statutory planning approval process before the scope is finalised and construction can start.

We are committed to working together with our school communities and stakeholders to deliver the best learning facilities for students. As the project progresses we will share details with the community for feedback.
