

Blakebrook Public School

Works notification | 26 March 2025

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild essential services, a project is underway to rebuild Blakebrook Public School after it was extensively damaged by floods in 2022.

Rosehill Road works

The rebuild of Blakebrook Public School includes providing bus parking, staff parking and student drop off facilities at the front of the school, alongside Rosehill Road.

Construction work to create these facilities will start shortly and take approximately 8 weeks to complete.

School buses

Construction is being staged so the area outside Blakebrook Public School can continue operating as a school bus interchange point during the works. There will be no change to usual school bus timetables or routes.

Parents and carers are however asked to avoid using the Blakebrook Public School site as a location for dropping off or picking up students from buses while the work is taking place. This will help minimise congestion and contribute to safety.

Traffic management

Rosehill Road will remain open in both directions during the works. Traffic management, including additional signage and stop and go traffic controllers, will be in place to manage traffic flows and maintain safe working.

Work hours

Work will take place between the standard working hours of 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm on Saturdays.
