Blakebrook Public School Project update | February 2025



Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is committed to rebuilding flood affected schools in the Northern Rivers region, ensuring we build back better with flood resilient schools for local students and local communities.

Funding for the school projects has also been provided by the Infrastructure Betterment Fund, which is jointly funded by the Australian and NSW Governments through the Disaster Recovery Funding Arrangements.

Project overview

A project is underway to rebuild Blakebrook Public School after it was extensively damaged by flooding in 2022. The project will deliver a raised and flood resilient school, with new classrooms, library, canteen and administration area, as well landscaping.

Progress summary

- The structural steel gantry that will support Blakebrook Public School's new school building modules was installed during the school holidays.
- The first school building modules were delivered on Wednesday, 5 February.
- Contractors also laid the pipes and cables needed to connect the school to power, water, internet and the stormwater system. This includes upgrading the school's electricity supply.

Next steps

The school module delivery will be completed on Thursday, 13 February, weather permitting.

After the modules are installed, we can begin the internal fit outs of the school spaces, including the classrooms, library, canteen and administration areas.

We expect the new flood resilient school facilities to be completed during Term 2, 2025. This includes landscaping of the school grounds ready for students and staff. We will keep the school community updated as construction continues throughout Term 1, and as we begin planning for the return of students and staff to Blakebrook.
