Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is committed to rebuilding flood affected schools in the Northern Rivers region, ensuring we build back better with flood resilient schools for local students and local communities. Funding for the school projects has also been provided by the Infrastructure Betterment Fund, which is jointly funded by the Australian and NSW Governments through the Disaster Recovery Funding Arrangements.

Project overview

A project is underway to rebuild Blakebrook Public School after it was extensively damaged by flooding in 2022. The project will deliver a raised and flood resilient school, with new classrooms, library, canteen and administration area, as well landscaping.

Progress summary

- The final finishes are being completed on the school's internal spaces.
- The lift to provide accessible access to the first floor has been installed.
- Landscaping has started. This includes work on installing the yarning circle, turf, shed, and sports court.
- The new bus interchange, staff parking and student kiss and drop off facility at the front of the school, on Rosehill Road are almost complete. The fencing will be completed shortly. Thank you everyone for your patience during this work.
