Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is committed to rebuilding flood affected schools in the Northern Rivers region, ensuring we build back better with flood resilient schools for local students and local communities.

Funding for the school projects has also been provided by the Infrastructure Betterment Fund, which is jointly funded by the Australian and NSW Governments through the Disaster Recovery Funding Arrangements.

Project overview

As part of this commitment, a project is underway to rebuild Blakebrook Public School, after it was extensively damaged during floods in early 2022. The project will deliver a flood resilient school, with new classrooms, library, canteen and administration areas, and landscaping.

Move in date confirmed

We are excited to confirm that work on this important project is nearly finished and the first day back at the rebuilt Blakebrook Public School will be **Monday 23 June 2025**.

Over the next few weeks, the team will be putting the finishing touches on the landscaping, relocating school resources and working with school staff to get everything ready to welcome students.

The new school turf has been laid but students are asked to remain off the grassed areas until after the July school holidays to allow it to establish and to give it the best chance to thrive.

Arriving at school

Parking and pedestrian access arrangements at the school will be the same as they were before the rebuild. The main entry for the school remains on Rosehill Road.

On Day 1 staff will welcome students back to Blakebrook and their new school. Students should put their bags downstairs in the undercroft and wait until the bell rings. Parents are welcome to stay for a barbecue breakfast with students and staff.
