Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild essential services, the 2023-24 Budget is delivering a record \$8.8 billion for new and upgraded schools. This targeted investment in growing communities will ensure working families get access to a world class public education.

Project overview

A project is underway to upgrade Bletchington Public School to provide students with the latest educational facilities and support the local community.

The upgrade includes a new two-storey learning hub with 10 new modern flexible classrooms, a hall upgrade, a new Information and Communication Technology (ICT) special programs unit, refurbishment of existing learning spaces including facilities for specialist support classes and multipurpose areas, replacement of the covered outdoor learning area (COLA) and upgraded connecting walkways.

Progress summary

The school started using their refurbished Kindergarten classrooms in Building 1, the upgraded hall, and COLA from Day 1 Term 4 2023. In Term 4, work has continued to refurbish the existing classrooms in buildings 7 and 8.

Summer holiday works

Construction will continue at Bletchington Public School over the school holidays to finish all remaining works for the school upgrade, including refurbishing classrooms and upgrading connecting walkways.

The remaining temporary demountable buildings will also be removed.

Holiday working hours

Work will take place within the approved construction hours of 7 am to 5 pm Monday to Friday. No work will take place on weekends or public holidays, unless otherwise advised.


Some deliveries to the site may need to take place outside of normal work hours because of the size of the trucks required. This is to minimise the impact on road users and the general public.
