Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild essential services, the 2023-24 Budget is delivering a record \$8.8 billion for new and upgraded schools. This targeted investment in growing communities will ensure working families get access to a world class public education.

Project overview

Planning is underway for an upgrade to Bomaderry High School. The upgrade will include fit-for-purpose classrooms and core facilities.

Progress update

We have continued to plan for the school upgrade in consultation with the Project Reference Group (PRG) and key stakeholders.

Planning has included reviewing results from surveys of teachers, school staff, students and parents on their experience with the school.

We have further developed the scope and concept design for the upgrade in response to the survey results and stakeholder feedback.

Plans for the upgrade focus on providing a new building for the school that will accommodate administration facilities and Technological and Applied Studies (TAS) classrooms, refurbishing existing classrooms and staff rooms, improving accessibility, upgrading toilets, and pedestrian improvements.

We have submitted the plans in a Final Business Case to NSW Treasury to request formal approval for the project to proceed. Once the business case is approved, we look forward to sharing the upgrade design with the community.

Next steps

We will begin to develop the concept designs into schematic designs. The schematic designs will consider further project details, such as floor layouts and the extent of refurbishments.

We will also start to prepare documentation to seek planning approval through a complying development certificate (CDC). Complying development is a combined planning and construction approval for straightforward development that can be determined through assessment by an accredited certifier.
