

Bomaderry High School

Works notification | 25 October 2024

A project is underway to upgrade Bomaderry High School with fit-for-purpose classrooms and core facilities.

Site establishment at Bomaderry High School

Following the completion of the detailed design and planning approvals, a construction site will now be established on 1 November 2024 in preparation for the construction of the new Building P.

Initial works will include the installation of site fencing and the set up of site sheds, followed by the delivery of machinery to commence the upgrades. Traffic management will be in place at both site entrances to maintain traffic flow and pedestrian safety, and to manage peak periods during school start and finish times.

Hours of work

All works will take place in standard construction hours, which are Monday to Friday between 7 am to 6 pm, and Saturdays between 8 am and 1 pm. No work will take place on Sundays or public holidays.

Managing construction impacts

The safety of the school's students, staff, visitors and the local community is our highest priority. Construction is planned so there is minimal impact on school operations. Safety measures are in place to separate the construction site from areas occupied by the school and ensure students are unable to enter construction areas. There is regular consultation with the school to discuss construction progress.
