




# Bomaderry High School upgrade


As part of the NSW Government’s plan to rebuild public education, the 2024-25 Budget is delivering record education funding, including a historic \$1.4 billion for new and upgraded schools in regional NSW. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world class public education.


The upgrade will include:

A new building with administration facilities and Technological and Applied Studies (TAS) classrooms. All new and upgraded TAS spaces at Bomaderry will be to a VET standard.

# Site plan

The site plan shows the location of the new building and how existing buildings will be refurbished and reconfigured.

The changes will improve the quality of general classrooms as well as facilities for science, visual arts, performance and fitness, and specialist support classes.

## Refurbishment of existing buildings

- Existing buildings will receive light, medium, or heavy refurbishment, depending on need.
  - Light refurbishment –refreshing finishes e.g. painting and replacing floor coverings.
  - Medium refurbishment –some changes to and replacement of finishes, services (e.g. sinks, aircon, AV equipment) and journey.
  - Heavy refurbishment –changing and replacing finishes, services and joinery (e.g. cabinets, doors, benches)

The map also shows the location for proposed pedestrian safety improvements.

## Proposed pedestrian safety improvements

- Bus bay works:
  - extending the footpath boarding area
  - line marking the bus bay
  - new waiting area in front of the new building
- New wombat crossing across the school driveway at the Cambewarra Road entry
- New wombat crossing across Lyndhurst Drive.

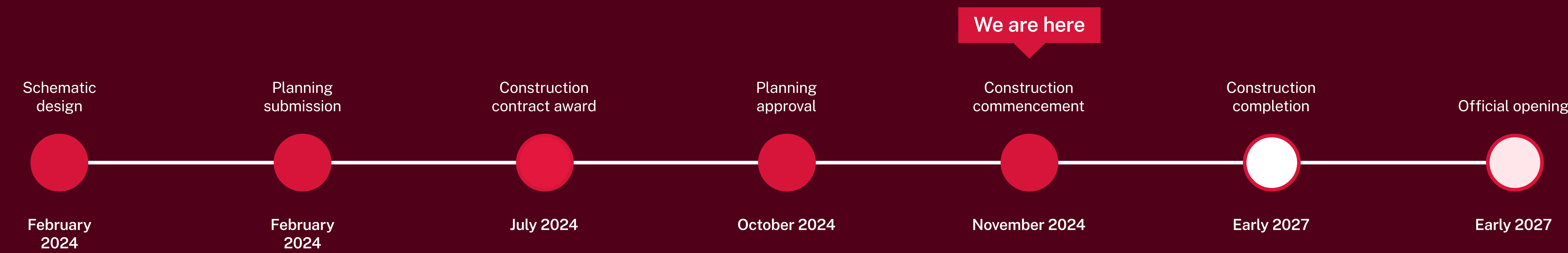
