Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild essential services, the 2023-24 Budget is delivering a record \$8.8 billion for new and upgraded schools. This targeted investment in growing communities will ensure working families get access to a world class public education.

Project overview

Planning is underway for an upgrade to Bomaderry High School. The upgrade will include fit-for-purpose classrooms and core facilities.

The project will deliver a new building with administration facilities and Technological and Applied Studies (TAS) classrooms, refurbished classrooms, refurbished staff rooms, upgraded toilets, accessibility improvements and pedestrian safety improvements.

Progress update

The business case for the Bomaderry High School upgrade has been approved by the NSW Government giving the project approval to proceed.

We have now completed the schematic design for the main upgrade works and look forward to sharing this with the community at an upcoming community information session. See overleaf for details.

Some minor refurbishment works have already started and we recently completed the refurbishment of staff and student toilets in Building D.

Next steps

We expect to release the construction contract tender to appoint a builder for the main upgrade work in mid-2024 and appoint a builder in late 2024. Once a builder is appointed, they will work on a timeline for construction.
