Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the NSW Budget is delivering \$2.1 billion for new and upgraded schools in regional NSW. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world class public education.

Project overview

A project is underway to upgrade Bomaderry High School. The upgrade will include fit-for-purpose classrooms and core facilities.

The project will deliver:

- a new building with administration facilities and Technological and Applied Studies (TAS) workshops and classrooms (completed October 2025)
- an upgrade of the existing kitchen to a Vocational Education and Training (VET) kitchen
- refurbished classrooms
- refurbished staff rooms
- upgraded toilets
- accessibility improvements
- pedestrian safety improvements.

Progress summary

Works for Building P are now finished and in use by students and staff. For those of you who have not seen the facilities in person, more images can be viewed in the [Welcome Pack here](#).

Works to refurbish Building B are now underway. The building's water and utilities services are now disconnected and works to strip out the interior and internal demolition has started.

These works will include internal refurbishments of classrooms for fitness, performance and visual arts, the VET kitchen, administration and staff, toilet upgrades, handrail and external upgrades.

Next steps

- Continue refurbishment works on Building B.
- Start the sports field upgrade.
- Main vehicle gate and pedestrian gate upgrade.
- Once Building B refurbishments are finished, we will start works to refurbish Building A. This will be the final stage in the upgrade project.

Sports field upgrade – from 1 December 2025

Works to upgrade the existing sports field will take place from Monday 1 December 2025. The works will include drainage upgrades to enable use in all-weather situations, and line markings and goal posts to support various football codes. The area will be cordoned off before works start and separated by construction fencing and inaccessible to students and staff.

We anticipate works to be finished and back in use by students and staff in February 2026.

The summer school holidays are an ideal time to complete the bulk of these works as it reduces the amount of time students and staff lose access.

School holiday works and contact information

Work will continue over the summer school holidays except for public holidays.

School Infrastructure will be closed from **Wednesday 24 December 2025 at 5 pm to Monday 12 January 2025 at 9 am**, inclusive, in line with the NSW Government shut down period.
