Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over four years to deliver more than 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over five years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Braidwood Central School

A project is underway to upgrade Braidwood Central School. This upgrade will include:

- two new buildings with six innovative general teaching spaces and two specialist learning areas, for music and drama
- refurbishment of two existing buildings
- new covered walkways and ramps
- refurbished outdoor spaces and play areas with modern landscaping
- refurbishment and extension of administration and staff facilities.

Progress summary

The main construction contractor has been awarded to Zauner Construction and the Development Application has been approved.

Site establishment and works commencement

Site establishment including the installation of hoarding and project signage, commenced on 27 May 2020 to prepare the site for construction.

The main works are expected to commence directly after site establishment.

Construction will take place between 7:00am and 6:00pm Monday to Friday, and 8:00am and 4:00pm on Saturdays. No work will take place on Sundays or public holidays, unless otherwise approved.

During construction, traffic management will be implemented to ensure the safety of students, teachers, staff, site visitors and residents.

Hoarding and shade cloth will be used to reduce noise and dust impact on the school and its neighbours. Dust from demolition and construction works will be hosed down with water as required. Deliveries will be scheduled outside of school pick up and drop off times where possible.

School Infrastructure NSW will work closely with the school community and neighbours to minimise impacts where possible.
