## Project update

### Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$7.9 billion over the next four years, continuing its program to deliver 215 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

### Project overview

A project is underway to upgrade Braidwood Central School while ensuring the heritage significance of its buildings are maintained.

The project includes:

- Two new buildings with six general learning areas and two specialist learning areas for music and drama
- A new administration building
- Upgrading two existing buildings
- New covered walkways and ramps
- Improved outdoor spaces and play areas with modern landscaping
- A new accessible carpark.

### Progress summary

Stage One, which delivered the new Building 4 and upgraded existing Buildings A, F and T was handed over to the school in December 2020. These buildings are now in use. All upgrade work to the existing buildings maintained their heritage significance.

Stage Two has progressed and new Building 1 is on-track for completion by the end of 2021.

New Building 2 will be completed earlier and is planned to be opened by August 2021, weather permitting.

Together, these new buildings will house the six general learning areas and the two specialist learning areas for music and drama.

### Next steps

The new accessible carpark has been completed ahead of schedule and will be opened in late-July.

On completion of Stage Two work and occupation of new Buildings 1 and 2 by the school, the demountable unit used as a music room will be removed.

We will continue to provide updates to the community as the project progresses.
