Weekend work to remove lead paint

We are upgrading Braidwood Central School with new and improved education facilities to support the student community.

Refurbishment works of Building A requires the removal of lead paint from the outside of the building. This work will take place:

- Saturday 5 September and Sunday 6 September 2020
- Saturday 12 September and Sunday 13 September 2020
- Saturday 19 September and Sunday 20 September 2020
- Saturday 26 September and Sunday 27 September 2020

This material will be removed in accordance with SafeWork NSW regulations. All work will be completed in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies and guidelines.

Testing will be completed to ensure the site has been fully remediated. The health, safety, and well-being of the school and the local community is our highest priority. Please be assured that the removal of this material will not pose a risk to the local community.

In line with the current NSW Environmental Planning and Assessment (COVID-19 Development – Construction Work Days Order 2020), during the COVID-19 pandemic, School Infrastructure NSW construction sites can operate on weekends and public holidays. This is to allow workers to abide by social distancing rules while on construction sites by distributing building work across the week. Construction work will take place between 8:00am and 4:00pm on Saturday and Sunday.
