Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is committed to rebuilding flood affected schools in the Northern Rivers region, ensuring we build back better with flood resilient schools for local students and local communities. Funding for the school projects has also been provided by the Infrastructure Betterment Fund, which is jointly funded by the Australian and NSW Governments through the Disaster Recovery Funding Arrangements.

Project overview

As part of this commitment, a project is underway to rebuild Broadwater Public School, after it was extensively damaged during floods in early 2022. The project will deliver raised and flood resilient school, with new classrooms, library, canteen and administration areas, as well as new landscaping.

Progress summary

- The structural steel gantry, lift shaft and front stairs have been installed.
- All school module buildings have been delivered and craned into place. Thank you to students, staff and community members who came to celebrate the milestone. Photos of the day are on the next page. You can watch a [timelapse of the module installation here](#).
- Work on the concrete undercroft slab has commenced.

Next steps

Construction will continue over the summer school holidays. This includes:

- work on the school's interior
- completion of the concrete undercroft slab
- installing pipes and cables.

Landscaping and services connection will begin in Term 1.



We are expecting completion of the Broadwater Public School during Term 1 2025 and will keep the school and community updated about the construction timeline and plans for moving back to Broadwater.

The site will be closed between 20 December 2024 and 3 January 2025. Construction will restart from Monday 6 January 2025 and will continue to align with our approved construction hours of 7 am to 6 pm Monday to Friday, and 8 am to 1 pm on Saturdays.
